Haere mai Whānau! Welcome to Term ! We have an action packed term ahead of us. Make sure you check out the key messages and dates for this term!

Big Ideas/Inquiry

This term, we will be thinking about ourselves as learners. Specifically, how we can change our thinking to enable ourselves to take risks in our learning and solve problems we consider difficult. We will also be looking at our local history, exploring the different perspectives of the Treaty of Waitangi, and building our knowledge of ANZAC Day.

Te Reo Māori

The children will be affirming their knowledge of their *mihi*, and creating their own. We start the day sharing karakia and waiata. . We are looking at the history of the Treaty of Waitangi. The children will work together to form their own Classroom Treaty.

Mathematics

There will be a strong focus on improving our students' basic facts knowledge alongside exploring place value and a range of number strategies. We are exploring Geometry as a strand, which looks at shape, coordinates, and changing shapes using transformation.

Reading

The students will take part in a range of learning activities and lessons that focus on developing decoding and comprehension strategies. This is applied through a range of fiction and nonfiction texts.

Writing

Children will explore the power of the words they use. They will work on being descriptive and painting a picture in their audience's head.

Home Learning

We encourage students to complete home learning. The children will be rewarded if they complete it and return it to their teacher but this is not compulsory.
